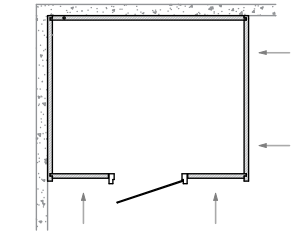


Como 2-150 INDOOR SAUNA

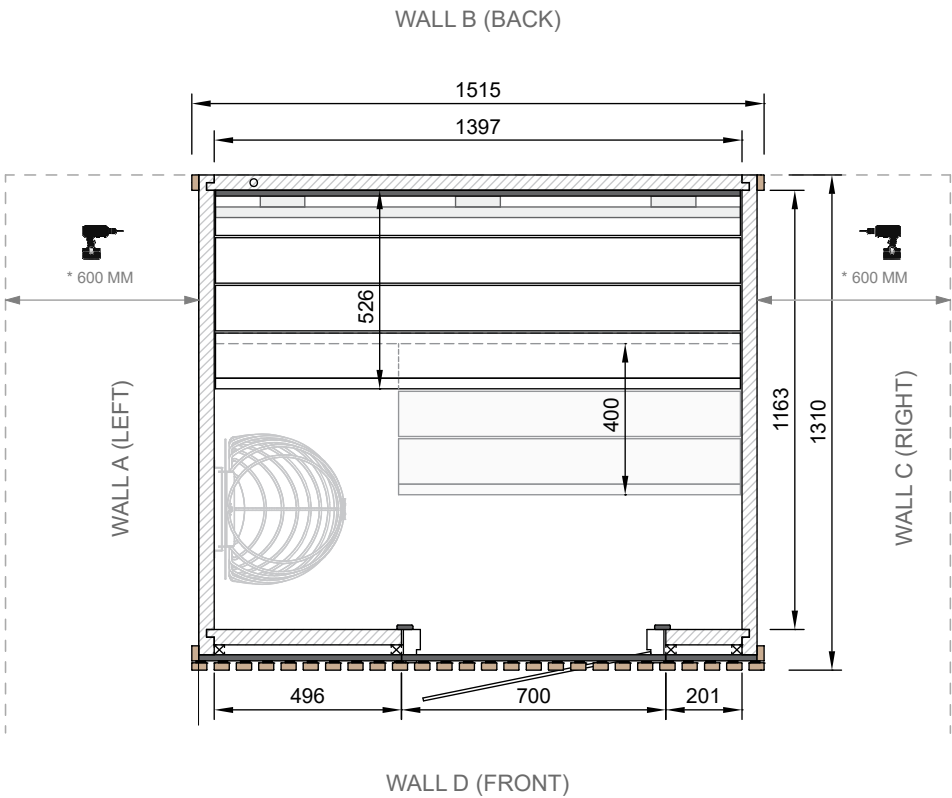

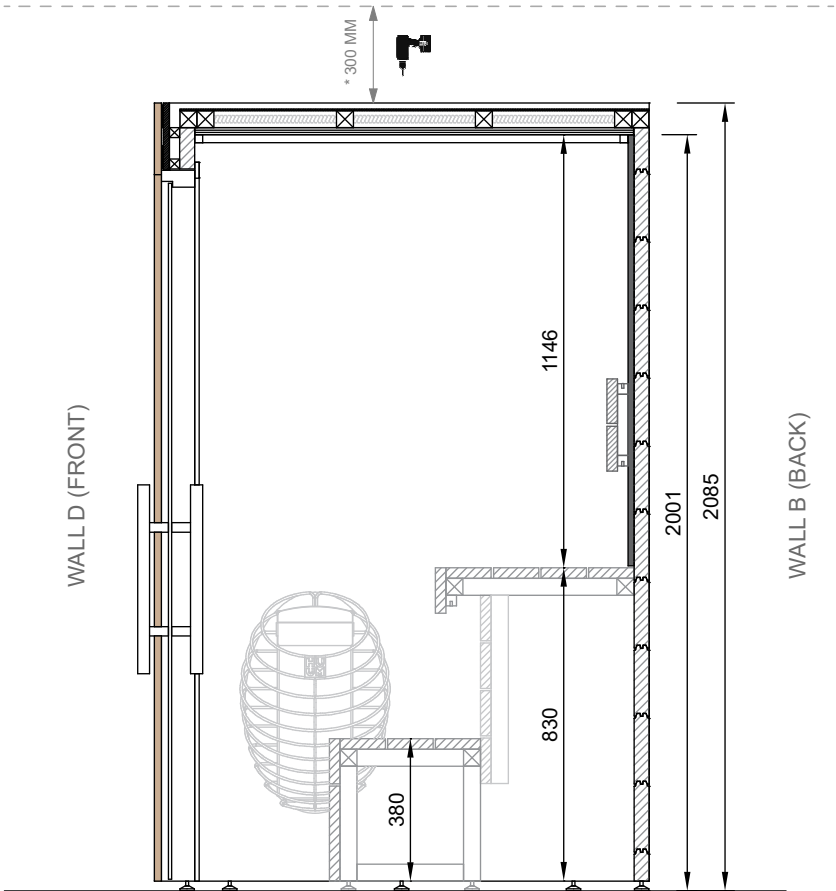


To place the sauna in a corner, assemble the wall logs first, then push it against the walls.

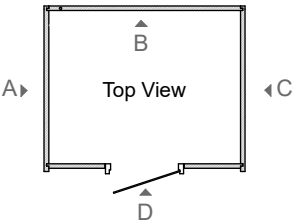

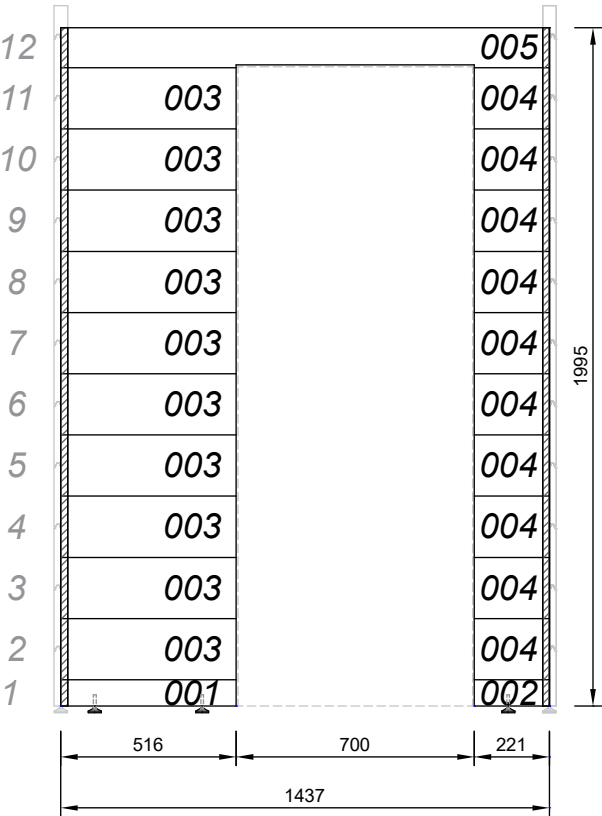


Wall Layout:

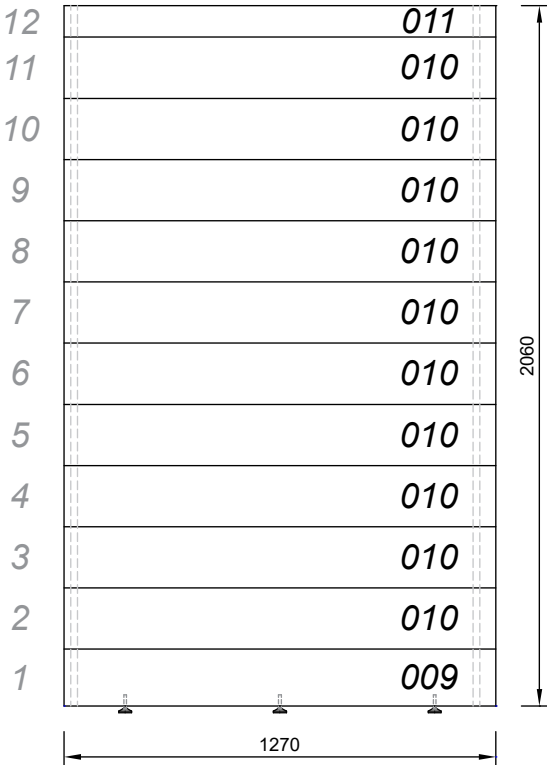
Continue stacking the wall logs according to the layout plan.
As you proceed, ensure that the pre-drilled cable conduit drillings are properly aligned.
To make ceiling installation easier, do not install the top wall log on the right wall at this stage.



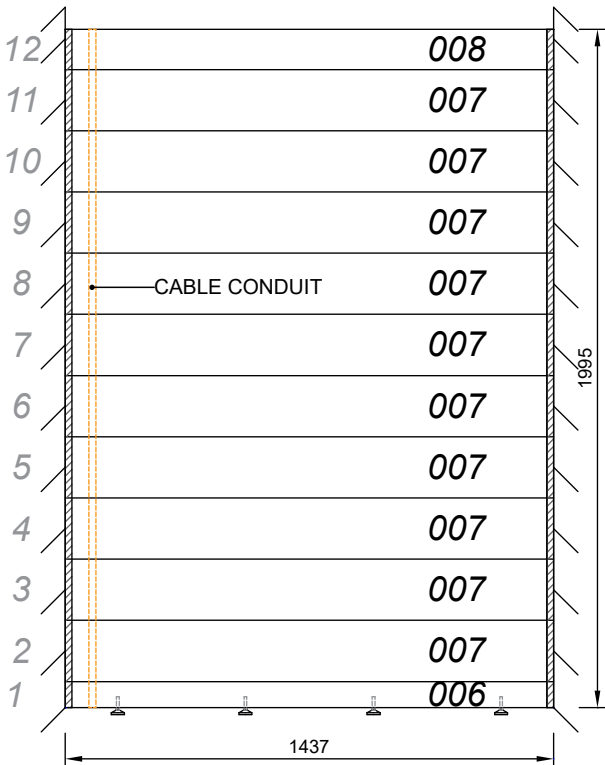
WALL D (FRONT)

VIEW FROM THE OUTSIDE

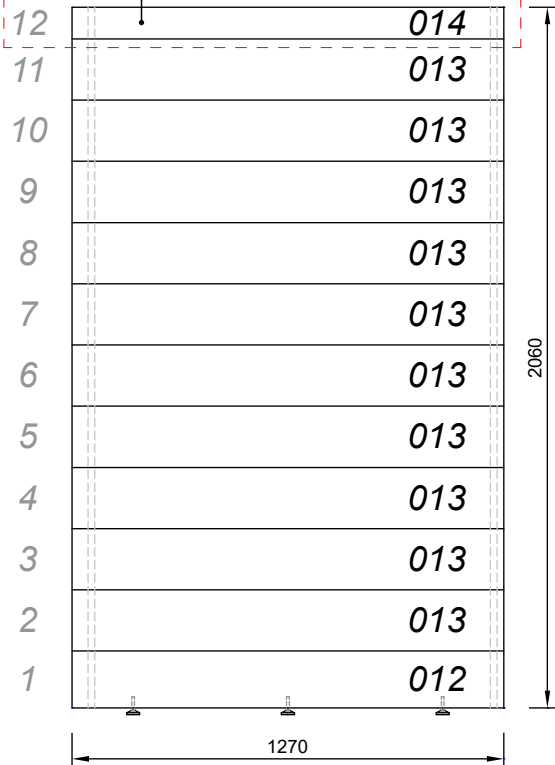


WALL B (BACK)
VIEW FROM THE INSIDE

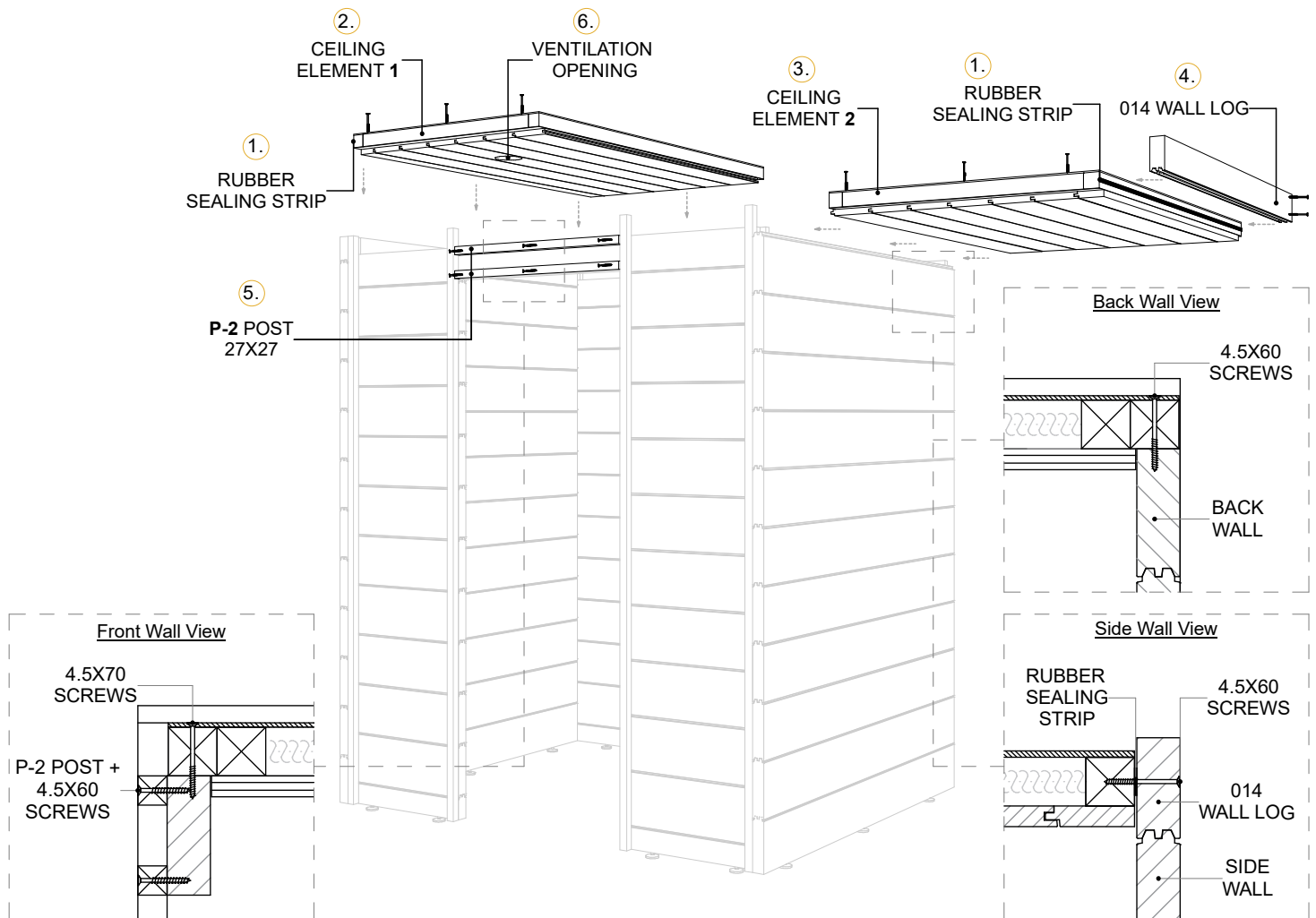


! INSTALL THE LAST WALL LOG

Ceiling Installation and Wiring:



Electrical Wiring:

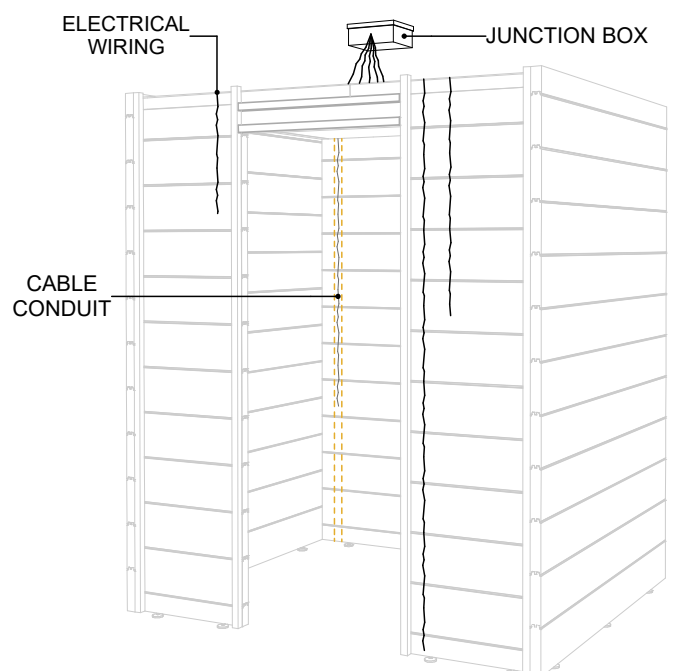
Choose the preferred side for installing the sauna controller, and plan the placement of the temperature sensors to ensure accurate readings and optimal performance.

Route the electrical wiring for the control panel, sensors and LED lighting under the sauna benches and behind the backrests (if ordered additionally) through the cable conduit, across the ceiling and along the front walls.

! Complete these steps before attaching the facade panels.

Connect the main power cable to the LED lighting wiring in the junction box.

The junction box can be placed on top of the ceiling elements for easy access and concealment, or in any other accessible location depending on site conditions.



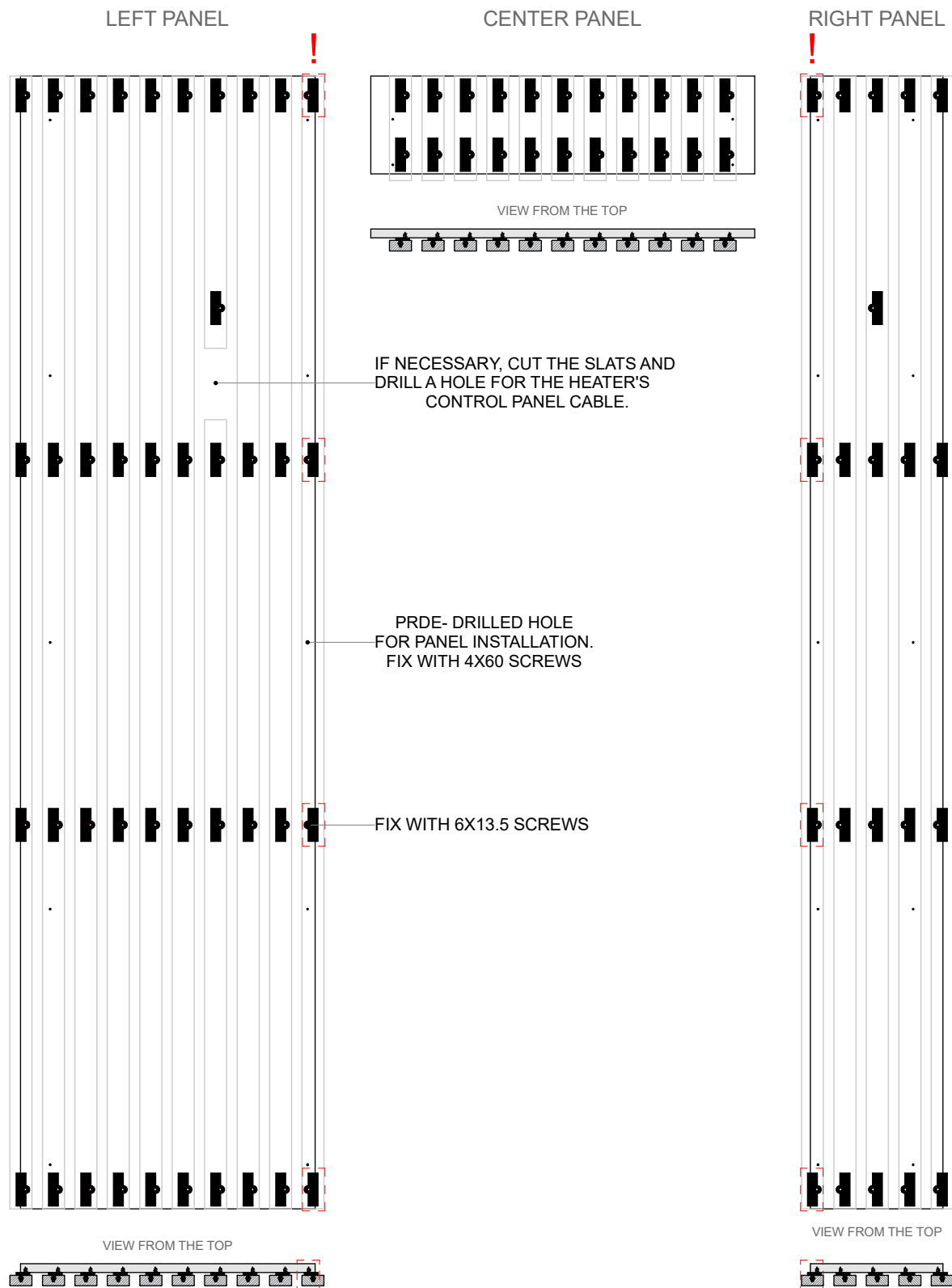
! Electrical installation must be carried out by a certified electrician to ensure safety and compliance with local regulations.

Fixing Clip Mounting Layout:

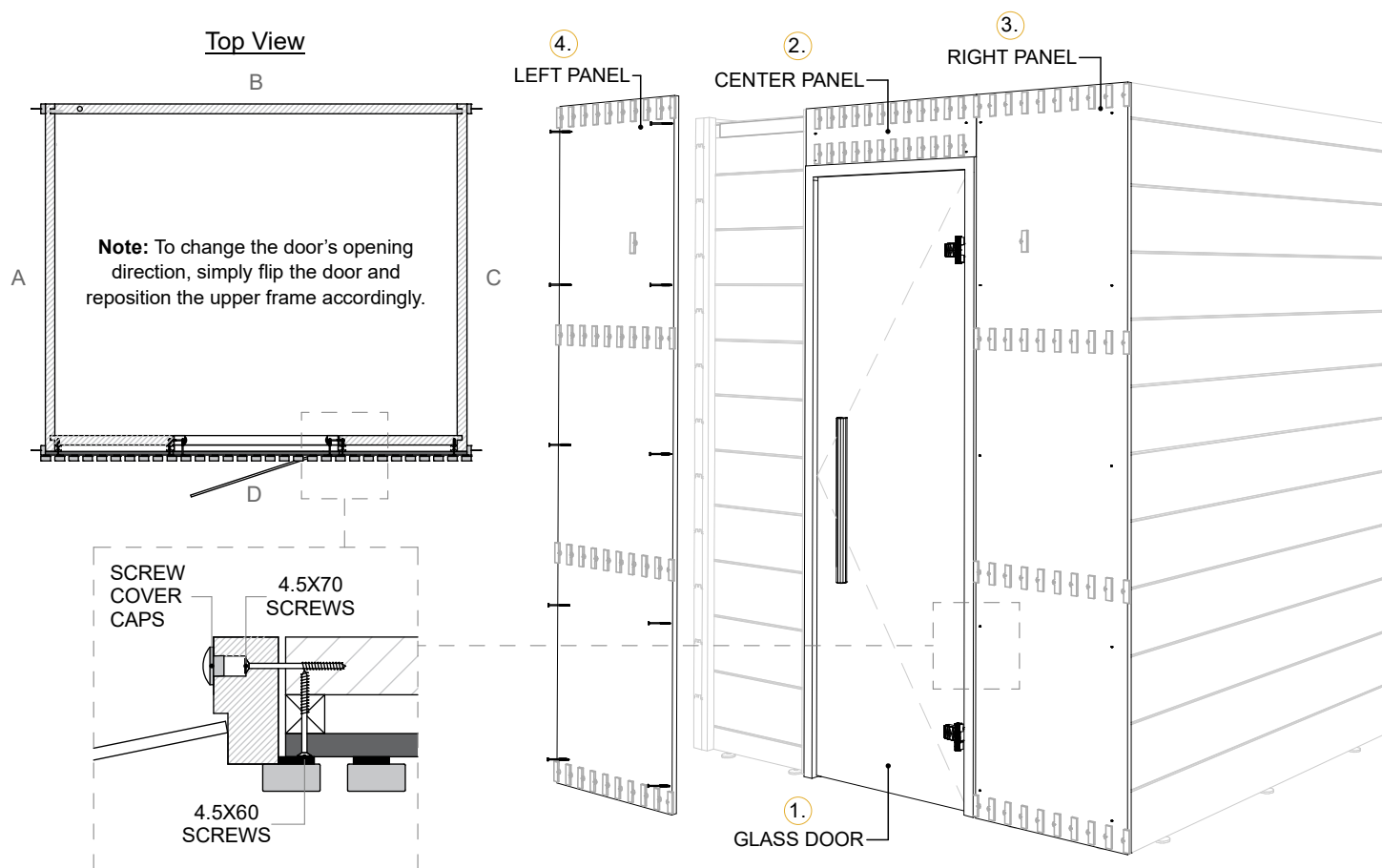
! Confirm that all electrical conduits, wiring, and associated components are completely installed, tested, and approved in their final locations prior to fixing the facade panels in place.

Attach the fixing clips to the facade panels using 6×3.5 mm screws, following the provided layout.

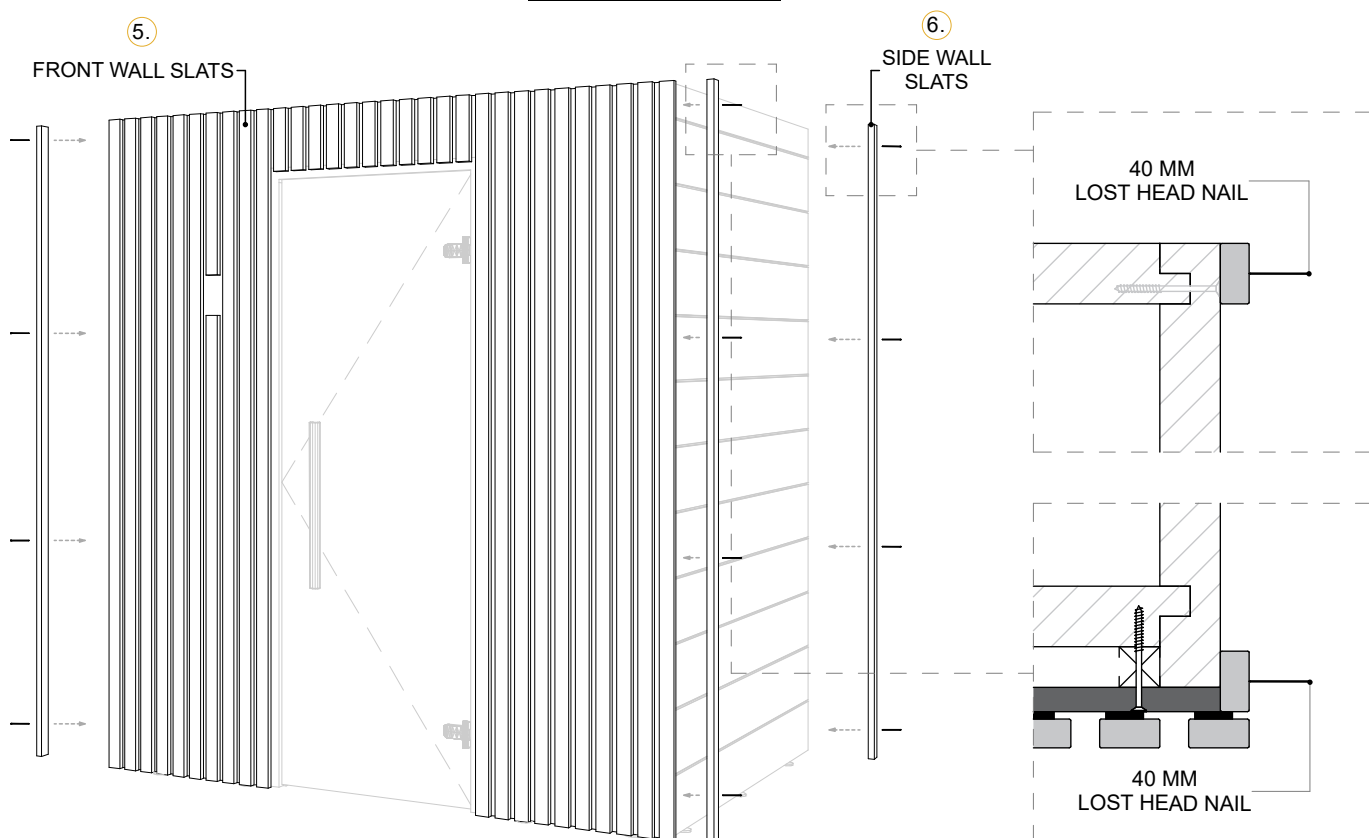
! Ensure each clip is positioned correctly—the screw placement affects the spacing, so pay close attention to maintain even gaps between the decorative slats.



Door and Facade Panel Installation:

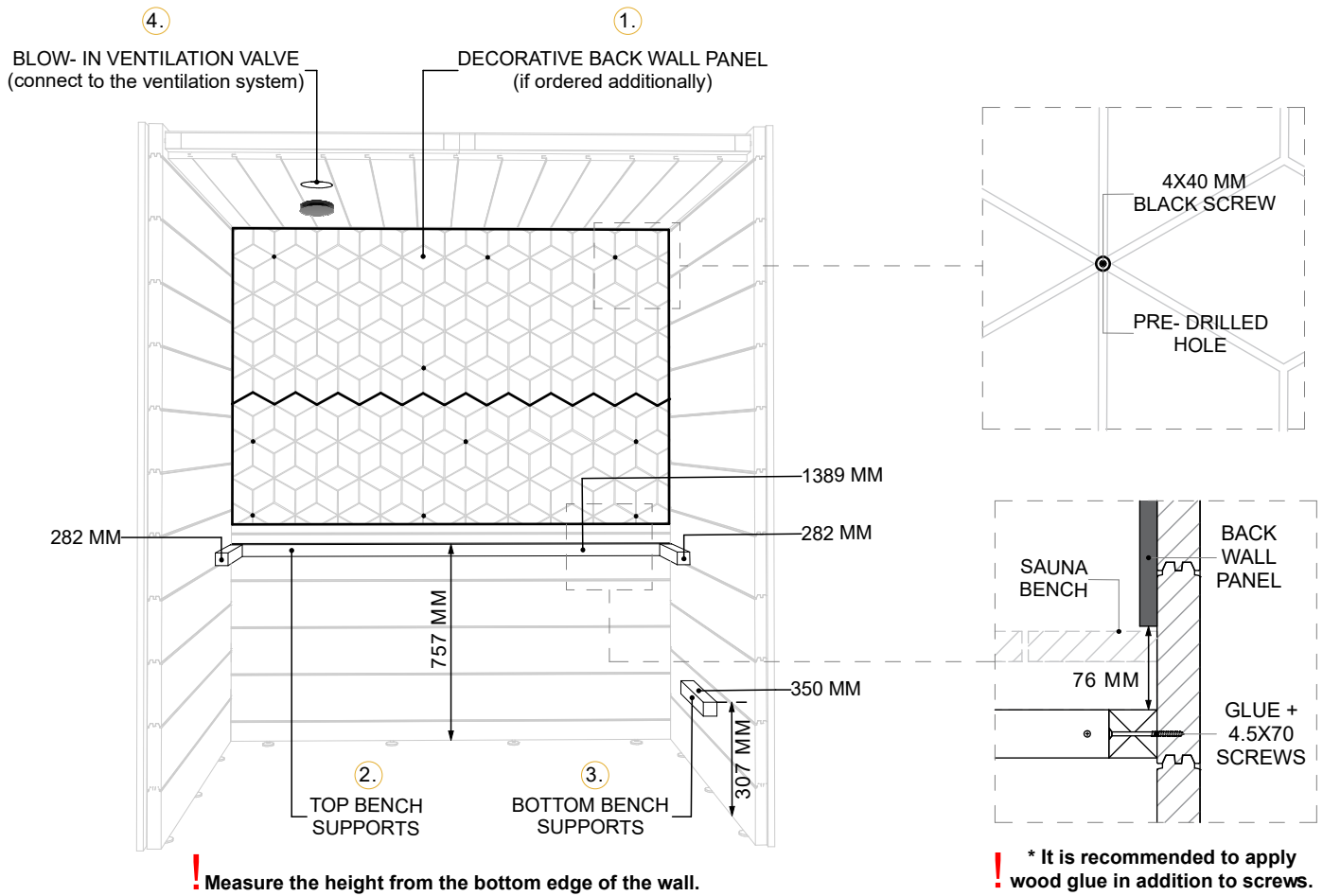


Decorative Slats:

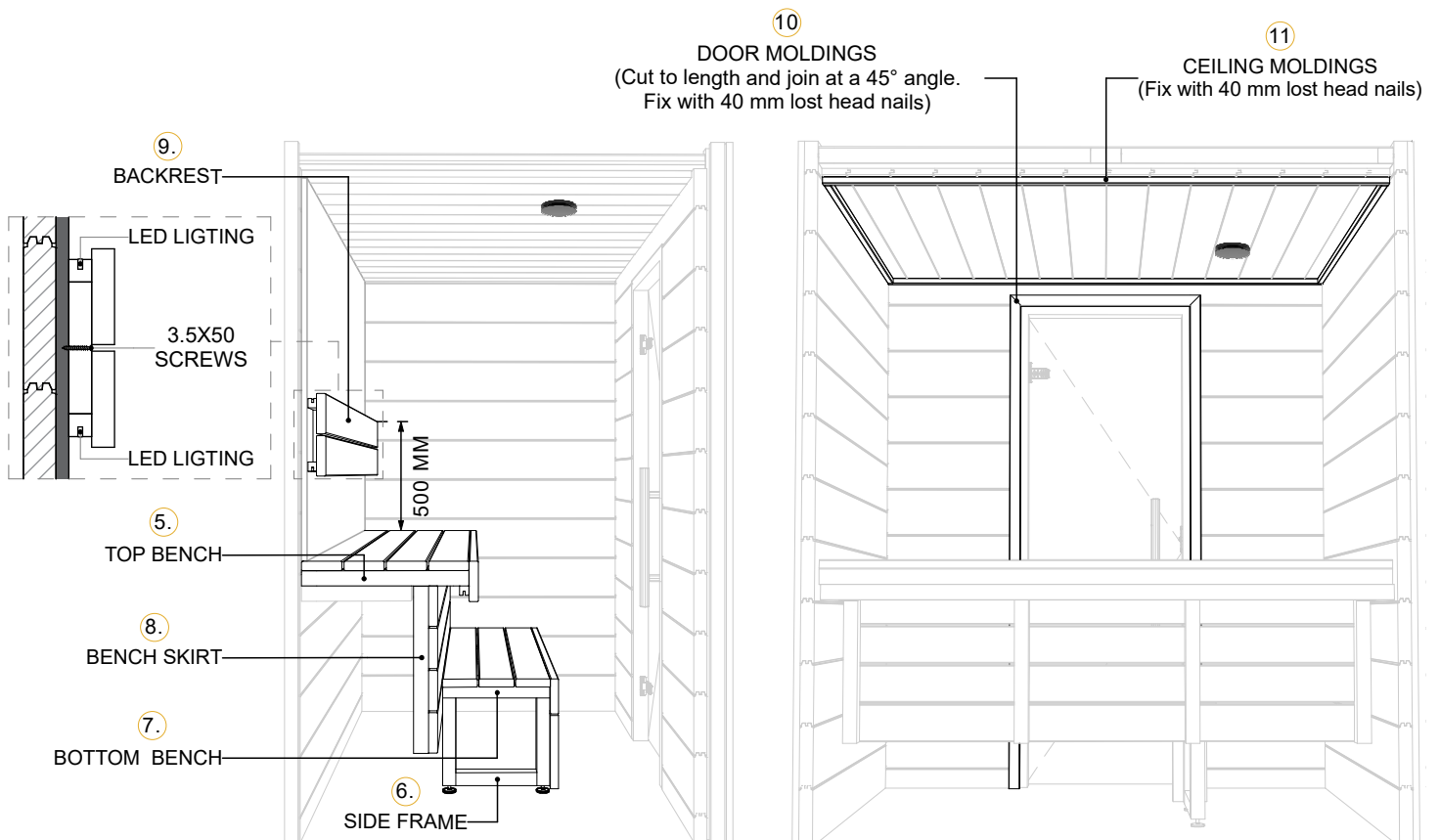


! Snap the decorative slats into place. Please note that they are not intended to be removed and reinstalled. In case of installation errors, four long and one short spare piece are included.

Safety Requirements and Maintenance

Safety Requirements for Indoor Sauna

Electrical Safety:

Only a certified electrician should install or service the sauna heater.

Use a properly grounded, sauna-rated power supply. Do not use extension cords or power strips.

Ventilation:

Ensure adequate ventilation to allow fresh air circulation and prevent overheating or humidity buildup.

Proper ventilation ensures a steady flow of fresh air, helps maintain a consistent temperature, removes excess humidity, and prevents mold or wood damage.

Heater Placement & Use:

Keep flammable materials (e.g. towels, paper, clothing) away from the heater.

Never cover the heater or place objects on it.

Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for sauna stone placement.

User Safety:

Limit sauna sessions to 15–20 minutes.

Stay hydrated and exit immediately if you feel dizzy, nauseated, or uncomfortable.

Children must be supervised at all times.

Pregnant individuals and people with heart conditions should consult a doctor before use.

Fire Safety:

Keep a smoke detector and fire extinguisher nearby (outside the sauna room).

Do not use candles or open flames inside the sauna.

Maintenance Guidelines for Indoor Sauna

After Use:

Leave the door open to allow moisture to escape and air to circulate.

Wipe down benches and walls with a damp cloth to remove sweat and residue.

Weekly inspect the heater and stones for cracks or displacement.

Clean the floor to remove dirt and debris.

Monthly check for signs of mold or mildew and clean with a mild sauna-safe disinfectant if needed.

Tighten screws and fittings if any parts have loosened.

Annually replace sauna stones if they are cracked or crumbling.

Have a licensed technician inspect the electrical components and heater performance.

General Tips:

Avoid harsh cleaners; use only non-toxic, sauna-safe products.

Use towels on benches to reduce sweat buildup and protect wood surfaces.

Re-oil or lightly sand wooden surfaces if they become dry or splintered (only with appropriate products).
